

Family Dog Training Level Three and CGC Preparation

This advanced dog training class takes the dog and owner on a journey exploring the different activities available to people wanting to get the most out of their dog's natural talents and abilities. Does he want to herd sheep? Be an agility champ? Therapy Dog? How about a Canine Good Citizen?

This class exposes both handler and dog to many of the endeavors available to trained dogs while at the same time preparing for the American Kennel Club Canine Good Citizen test. It will be fun, rewarding and enlightening as you learn more about what dogs can do and what talents your dog has and wants to use.

Sheep Herding: Dogs are given the opportunity to herd sheep in a controlled situation. Location for this class is Terry's ranch north of Fort Collins.

Advanced Obedience and Obedience Title Work: Want to know if your dog can earn an obedience title? What's involved? Can he really do what it takes? Learn the rules and the ropes of the AKC obedience ring.

Therapy Dog: How well would your dog do as a Therapy Dog? Visiting the sick, entertaining and lending comfort to the elderly? Find out when we take the dogs on a field trip to a Fort Collins residential care facility.

Canine Good Citizen Certification Preparation:

Is your dog a canine good citizen? Will he accept a friendly stranger? Ignore another dog? Come when called and stay when told? If yes, then he may be eligible for the American Kennel Club's "Canine Good Citizen" certificate. A coveted certification that may open doors and allow opportunities not given unqualified dogs.
